If every player repairs their ball mark and at least three (3) others our greens would look better and have a smoother putting surface. Help yourself and other members by repairing ball marks.

USGA TIP: Try not to lean on a club when on the putting green as the extra pressure, especially when removing a ball from the hole, can stress the grass.

DEMOS: We have an abundance of demo clubs for everyone to try, however, in order to give everyone the opportunity to try different clubs it will be necessary to limit the demo check out to a max of 2 days.

Summer finally arrived, or so it would seem. Once the rains ended the heat was upon us. You all have noticed the bad spots in the fairways no doubt. We had too much rain and then 95 degrees behind it. Most of the spots are either where water stood and the turf boiled or poa in the fairways puking out. Once we dried out a bit and controlled our water applications the bluegrass began to mend. The other thing we are struggling with now is non-working irrigation heads. This weather shows them in a hurry. We are doing our best to correct the problems and lose as little turf as possible.

We have had luck, thus far, with the tunnel pumps on #18. However, this past week we began experiencing problems with #15. After much study I have decided that the problem is over my head and we have called in experts. They will be here July 25 and hopefully get us back up and running properly. We have been lucky so far and missed any big rains that would have closed the tunnel. Lets hope that holds out a few more days.

Well when we are not working on irrigation and broken tunnels we have made some progress on the flowerbeds, killing weeds and adding mulch. We have also removed several dead trees. We continue working on the cart paths, and the bunkers are back in shape after the floods. The greens seem to be healthy and rolling well and for the most part the fairways and roughs are decent. I feel we are pretty good heading toward August.
