Summer left for a little while but now it is back it seems. It came back at just the wrong time, while we were punching greens. Yes we were early this year by at least a week. We really didn't want to do it before Labor Day but due to scheduling conflicts with the company we contract to do it we had to go now or wait way too late. Everything went very smooth the first day. We got all the greens punched and cleaned off and the first 12 we got sanded and broomed. We also punched all of the fairways that day. Then the rains came and really slowed progress on the rest of the greens. However, the rains were a blessing because of the heat the day before. You can see the difference on the greens we finished and watered earlier in the day and the ones that didn't get water until late afternoon and early evening. They got too hot and had too much traffic on them while they were hot. We are now 6 days out from the injury and they are starting to perk back up but it is going to take time and cooler weather to get them back where we want them. The collars took the brunt of the abuse along with any ridges and humps. Just to give you an idea, we had a tractor punching them, then a chain drag behind a cart, then a broom behind a cart, then a top dresser behind a cart, then the chain drag and broom again. It is always a lot of wear and tear but the heat and wind just compounded it all. Most of the injury is superficial and should get mowed off in the coming days but there will be some thinning of the turf here and there.

We still have to punch tees and plan to tackle them this coming week. Then we will begin seeding. We are fighting leaks like crazy and have let them stack up a bit this last week. We are going to take time to fix several before we gear up for the next phase. We are planning to add sand to bunkers again this fall. We are also planning to sod some holes in the fairways again. We made a big dent in them last fall and want to get some more of them this year. We have had success killing weeds in the native and want to get back after that soon also. It is a busy time and we will surly be in your way some. We will do our best to make it as minimal as possible for you.
