October is here and the end of the season is quickly approaching. It has been a pretty good year thus far. We have had several bouts of hot weather but all of them have been relatively short lived and followed by a cool down. We have also had plenty of moisture for the most part, and have skirted several of the bigger storms as well. This year we tried something different with the carts in rough rule. I am very happy to say it has had a profound effect on our fairways and I want to thank all of you for your help and support. Likewise, you all will be happy to know that it is almost over. As of September 15, 2009 we suspended the cart rule until next season. We feel that this is a prime date as we should be through aerification by then and the weather should be pretty mild from there on out. Also we want to give the roughs a break and see what we need to do to regain their "roughness". Another issue we have faced is the vandalism on #9 green. We replaced the largest damaged areas with sod from the chipping green. This sod has done remarkably well for this time of year. We are going to skip #9 green when we punch them but we are still going to top dress it fairly heavily. This should help to level out any of the remaining bad spots. We opened the green fully over Labor Day weekend. Grub season is upon us and we do have our control down. Let's hope it works and that the areas we don't treat can be spared as well. We began our skunk trapping and relocation program right after Labor Day. It has worked well for us the last two years and should be great again this time. September/October are busy months for us but we will try to disrupt your free time as little as possible. 744-0400
